President's Column

My family moved to Indian Spring eight years ago. Our first impression was that it was like a Hollywood movie set of a neighborhood—kids playing on the street, the community newsletter being delivered by wagon, picturesque streets and houses, neighbors that cared about each other. It seemed too good to be real. Eight years later, we know it is *very* real.

I was honored to be elected ISCA president, and appreciate the opportunity to serve the neighborhood which has served my family so well these past years.

We have an exciting season ahead, with the Fall Fest on October 21 and a debate between U.S. Congressional candidates Al Wynn and Donna Edwards on November 8th which ISCA will cosponsor near our neighborhood.

Our first general meeting on September 17 will focus on the controversy over the fate of the proposed music venue in downtown Silver Spring—including the collapse of the deal between Montgomery County and the Birchmere and the new negotiations with Live Nation. We hope to see as many of you as possible at the meeting and to hear your thoughts and concerns about the future of entertainment in downtown Silver Spring.

Thanks to everyone who braved the heat and humidity to participate in Indian Spring's National Night Out event on August 7th. Officers from the Montgomery County Police, Silver Spring division paid a visit to affirm their commitment to keeping our neighborhood safe.

Though we live in a low crime neighborhood, there has been a series of car break-ins here in which items were stolen from residents' vehicles. One of the officers at the National Night Out event pulled me aside and asked me to urge everyone not to leave anything of value in their cars. He suggested taking vehicle registrations, identifying documents and other valuables such as GPS devices out of the car rather than leaving then in glove compartments where they could fall prey to car thieves.

Having only been President since July, I am already impressed by the talent and dedication of the ISCA Board. The Board is working on developing compelling topics for future general meetings as well as some potential special events and initiatives that will be new to ISCA.

We are also working to streamline our website so that you can join ISCA or renew your membership online. We urge all of you to join or renew. The more members we have, the more great things ISCA can do.

News From Northwood High...

Northwood High School, the high school serving students who live in Indian Spring, will operate with all four grade levels in 2007-2008. The school, which was closed by the county in 1985 for declining enrollment, reopened in September 2004 with just a 9th-grade class and has added a grade level each year since, leading to this year's enrollment of approximately 1,350 students.

The school is introducing the Early College Scholars
Program this semester. The program is allowing 26
seniors to take one or more undergraduate courses during
the school day in a variety of disciplines at University of
Maryland for college credit. Also debuting this fall is the
Northwood Wellness Center, available to the community
as well as students and staff.

Principal Henry Johnson Jr. has announced the school will add a new academy program next fall: the Academy of Musical Theater. The school has three existing academies, all of which are open to students in the Downcounty Consortium.

Lastly, Northwood will host its first Homecoming football game at its newly refurbished stadium behind the school on Saturday, October 13. The opponent is Einstein HS, and game time is 2 p.m.

Northwood is located at 919 University Blvd. West. It has an active PTSA and a sports boosters group, both of which meet monthly during the school year.


