ISCA residents are asked to participate in the painless fundraising program at Northwood High School (or the school of your choice) simply through their weekly grocery shopping.

If you do not have a school-age student, please consider supporting Northwood, which draws several students from Indian Spring. Susan Luck, an ISCA neighbor, coordinates the fundraising program for the Northwood PTSA.

There are four ways to help:

- 1. RENEW your Safeway Club card
 - a. Go to www.escrip.com
 - b. Click on the YES, CHECK Mark at the bottom left of the page
 - c. Enter either your Safeway Club Card # (call 1-877-Safeway for card #) or your email address or your phone # to RENEW.
 - d. If you are supporting Northwood for the first time, the NHS ID is 500003142.
- 2. REGISTER your Giant Club card
 - a. Go to www.giantfood.com/aplus
 - b. Click on Our Stores tab located in the green bar towards the top of the screen
 - c. Go to Column titled A+ and click on Register Your Card tab

- d. Under the Sign In to Register Your Card box, fill in the first three letters of your last name and your Giant card number.

 (Call 1-877-366-2668 for card #)
- e. Select a School ID # (Northwood's ID is 04641)
- f. Click Complete registration box
- 3. Save your Snider's receipts
 - a. Mail receipts to NHS or contact PTSA rep Jim Burke [jaburke@erols.com] for pickup.
 - b. No cards, registering, or renewing? Just save the receipts!
- 4. ONLINE Shopping
 - a. Before doing any online shopping, go to NHS website:
 - montgomeryschoolsmd.org/schools/northwoodhs/b. Scroll down the Right Side of the screen until you see eScrip Online Mall and click on
- it
- c. Choose where you want to shop.
- d. Shop, buy and earn money for NHS.
