

a news media "rock star" since releasing his expose in mid-February about how a handful of big companies have monopolized control of Americans' meat supply through a high-tech sharecropping system. Forty years ago, he says, there were 36 companies around the country that produced chicken. Today, there are only two.

As the author of *The Meat* Racket: The Secret Takeover of America's Food Business (Simon & Schuster). Leonard has been making the rounds of national media, including National Public Radio's "Morning Edition" and "Splendid Table" and MSNBC's Morning Joe." He's hosted a series of book signings from the Pacific Northwest through midtown Manhattan in recent weeks. Even a Maryland state senator, Rich Madeleno, mentioned the book in a legislative briefing in Annapolis not long after the book first went on sale.

Both *The New York Times* and *The Washington Post* ran favorable reviews of Leonard's work in their March 2 editions.

His book doesn't much address the physical or nutritional aspects of what shows up on your plate but rather the chicken industry itself. As NPR reported: "Leonard focuses on the economic machinery that delivers the meat to us, or, as he puts it, 'the hidden power structure that has quietly reshaped U.S. rural economies while gaining unprecedented control over the nation's meat supply.' His book aims a spotlight at Tyson Foods, which helped create the modern chicken industry. And it recounts the stories of people, mostly farmers, whom Leonard contends Tyson has chewed up and cast aside since its incorporation in 1947."

A Schmidt Family Foundation fellow based at the New America Foundation, a nonpartisan public policy organization in Washington, Leonard previously was a national business reporter

with The Associated Press, focusing on agribusiness. His work has appeared in *Fortune*, *Slate* and *The New York Times*. He and his wife moved to Indian Spring from St. Louis." \*



# **Neighborhood Teen Takes Artwork Honor**




