PRESIDENT'S COLUMN

Roadwork to resume on 495 bridge at University Blvd. (March 26, 2014) – The State Highway Administration advises motorists who use the MD 193 (University Boulevard) bridge above I-495 (Capital Beltway) in Silver Spring of new traffic patterns as work on the span moves forward.



Beginning this Sunday night at 7 p.m., and continuing each night through Thursday, April 3, crews will shift all lanes of traffic to the eastbound side of MD 193 to prepare for demolishing and reconstructing the westbound half of the bridge. Maryland State Police will assist crews in implementing the traffic switch this week, as intermittent traffic stops of up to 15 minutes may be necessary to perform the work. Weather permitting, all phases of the traffic shift should be complete by Friday morning at 5 a.m.

Taste the World in Fenton Village

The Taste the World food and entertainment festival returns to Silver Spring's Fenton Village on Sunday, May 4, 2014. The 4th annual event highlights the diversity of restaurants in the area and will run from 1 p.m. to 5 p.m., with a raffle at 5:30 p.m.

This "restaurant crawl" offers \$2 - \$5 sample appetizers and tasting plates with international flavors. Rain or shine, 31 restaurants will welcome event attendees to sample their unique cuisines and cultures. Participating restaurants include Ethiopian, Greek, Indian, Nepali, Chinese, Mexican, Italian and Thai cuisine.

"Taste the World in Fenton Village is different from other food-themed festivals because participants actually walk into the restaurants and get a feel for the community," said Evan Glass, chair of the Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board, which organizes the event. "The goal is for diners to return to the mom-and-pop restaurants they like—which I hope is all of them."

Beyond the great restaurants, Taste the World will feature music and entertainment on two stages, information tables from local sponsors and nonprofits, free talks about Silver Spring history at the old B&O station, and a raffle with exciting prizes.

Pick up your event "passport" at the music stage located at public parking Lot 3 off Fenton Street between Thayer and Silver Spring avenues. Get your passport stamped at a minimum of three participating restaurants and turn it in back at the starting point for a chance to win prizes. Participating restaurants are mapped on the passport and will be marked with balloons and signs.

The raffle Grand Prize is a "Weekend for 2 in Silver Spring," which features an exciting package of car service, hotel stay, dinner, entertainment, and breakfast or lunch.

The Silver Spring Citizens Advisory Board and Silver Spring Town Center, Inc., co-host this volunteer-driven annual event in collaboration with local small business owners, and with the support of corporate sponsors and government.


